



## **Solid Hardwood Flooring**

### **Maintenance & Care Guide**

**Warranty coverage may be lost due to failure to strictly abide by all installation instructions and recommendations in this manual. This includes the use of improper tools or materials.**

## **Finishing & Maintenance**

Once installation is completed, vacuum the floor and clean with a hardwood floor cleaner and a slightly dampened mop. This will set your new floor to the right condition.

- Do not flood your floor with water.
- Use wood putty to smoothen the small holes left by finishing nails.
- Immediately wipe off any excess wood putty, using a clean cloth and cleaner.
- Do clean the floor with a solvent-based cleaner.
- Allow it to dry for an hour.

## **Regular Maintenance**

It is easy to care for your solid hardwood flooring. Simply just dust, mop or vacuum your wood floor as needed.

If necessary, spray wood floor cleaner on a slightly dampened sponge mop or cloth applicator and clean with a few strokes. Waxing your floor is also not recommended.

## **Preventive Maintenance**

### **Do's**

- Use protective mats at doorways, as gritty sand and dirt are abrasive to wood floors.
- Install floor protectors or unnoticeable felt pads on furniture legs.
- Remove split immediately.

### **Don'ts**

- Do not flood your floor with water.
